The 2022 WA Speedway Commission safety audit found that the club needed to install new control lights and upgrade the existing lighting at the track. Subsequently, the track was downgraded from Grade 1 to Grade 2, and this limits the race divisions available to the club, and will impact on the number of competitors.

The Shire is willing to contribute funds towards this project. No budget allocation has been made at this stage but Council have committed to providing the funds on the condition that the club are successful with the grant and complete the works before June 24.

The Morawa Speedway Association has the required funds to complete the project based on quotes received, they also have funds to cover a minor shortfall should it arise.

The Morawa Speedway Association covers all costs associated with operating the facility including the cost of powering the floodlights. The move to LED will reduce power consumption and costs for the club.

3. Please provide any additional comments regarding this applications merit against the assessment criteria to support your project rating and ranking.

The Morawa Speedway Associations grant application meets the criteria for extra funding due to Morawa's remote location, the energy reduction impacts of the project as the club runs a diesel generator so less energy being consumed not only saves on costs but will reduce emissions, and the improved lighting will allow the track to return to its Grade 1 rating. A improved grading will improve the standard of racing on offer, but will also improve the safety of drivers, and encourage new racers as the track offers more amenity for drivers.

The sport of speedway has a big impact on Morawa and is one of the only sports in the district that attracts participants from across the State. The track improvements will benefit the whole district and the region as it will increase the attractiveness of the location to competitors from all across the state. It will also allow the club to attract special events or competitors from overseas which will increase sporting participation, as well as having an economic impact on the local area.
