Conditions of Entry

1. GENERAL

- 1.1 Awards are open to all Morawa Residents, who either have a residential or postal address within the Morawa (6623) district. This includes students boarding at the Western Australian College of Agriculture- Morawa.
- 1.2 Entry forms and art work must be received no later than the close of business on Thursday 21 August 2025. No details, or entry forms, will be changed after this date. Late entries will not be accepted under any circumstances.
- 1.3 Winners will be decided by a 'People's Choice' voting system and the decision is final and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into.
- 1.4 All works entered into the Exhibition across all categories, must relate to the Exhibition theme-'Through our Eyes- A Celebration of Morawa'. Works that do not align with the theme may be excluded from the Exhibition.

2. CATEGORIES & JUDGING

- 2.1 All artworks must be entered by a Morawa Resident who has either a residential or postal address within the Shire of Morawa (6623). Votes will be taken during the exhibition opening period, with 1 vote per category per visitor allowed. The winner of each category will be the artist whose artwork receives the most votes at the conclusion of the exhibition.
- 2.2 Maximum three (3) entries per person, with only three (3) entries per category. Youth Artists may enter 1 piece of artwork per youth category.
- 2.3 Diptychs and triptychs will be classed as one (1) entry, however only one multi-panel entry per artist is allowed.

- 2.4 There are five (5) main entry categories. Each entry must be entered into one of these categories to be eligible for exhibition and judging. These are Works on Canvas/ Paper, Three Dimensional Art, Photography, Youth Canvas/Paper Works and Youth Photography.
- 2.5 There are five (5) 'People Choice' judged awards.
 These are 18+ Photography Award, Canvas/Paper Works
 Award, Three Dimensional Works Award, Youth (9-17 Years)
 Photography Award and Youth Canvas/Paper Works
 Award.
- 2.6 The Shire of Morawa reserve the right to not accept entries if they are deemed to be inappropriate or offensive.
- 2.7 Works on Canvas/ Paper \$400 prize money will be awarded to the artwork which receives the most votes via a 'People's Choice' voting system for best work on canvas or paper. Open to artists who reside or have a postal address within the Shire of Morawa (6623) or attend the Western Australia College of Agriculture- Morawa.
- 2.8 **Photography Award** -\$400 prize money will be awarded to the photograph who receives the most votes via a 'People's Choice' Voting System. Open to artists who reside or have a postal address within the Shire of Morawa (6623) or attend the Western Australia College of Agriculture- Morawa.
- 2.9 Three Dimensional Award \$400 prize money will be awarded to the artwork which receives the most votes via a 'People's Choice' voting system. 3D artworks can include, but are not limited to, textiles, sculpture, jewellery, handmade furniture, and ceramics. Open to artists who reside or have a postal address within the Shire of Morawa (6623) or attend the Western Australia College of Agriculture- Morawa.

- 2.10 Youth Works on Canvas/Paper \$100 prize money awarded to the artwork which receives the most votes via a 'People's Choice' voting system. Open to artists 9-17 years old at time of entry who resides within the Shire of Morawa, or boards at the Western Australian College of Agriculture-Morawa. Youth artists may only enter one (1) piece of artwork per category. Artwork by youth artists may not be entered into the main award categories.
- 2.11 Youth Photography \$100 prize money awarded to the photograph which receives the most votes via a 'People's Choice' voting system. Open to artists 9-17 years old at time of entry who resides within the Shire of Morawa, or boards at the Western Australian College of Agriculture-Morawa. Youth photographers may only enter one (1) photography works. Photography works by youth artists may not be entered into the main award categories.

3.ARTWORK SPECIFICATION

- 3.1 All artworks must be the artist's own original artwork.
- 3.2 All entries must be accompanied by a signed entry form, which can be obtained from the Shire of Morawa Website or at the Shire Administration Office.
- 3.3 All work on paper and photography works must be framed. A stretched canvas is considered a suitable frame and does not require additional framing. This will be at the cost of the artist.
- 3.4 All artwork, including sculptures, must not weigh more than 25kgs.
- 3.5 All 3D artwork must not exceed 50 cm wide x 50 cm deep by 250cm height. Any 3D work over 80cm high must be freestanding with their own support for being displayed on the floor, all other freestanding artwork must be able to be displayed on a standard size plinth.
- 3.6 All 2D artworks must not exceed 150 cm height x 125 cm width x 10 cm depth. These dimensions include the framing.
- 3.7 All 2D work must have appropriate hanging devices attached, e.g., flat D-rings and cord or wire. Works that are not ready to be hung will not be displayed.

- 3.8 All Artwork must be clearly labelled on the back with
 the artist's name, phone number, category, title of work.
 3D artworks come with a small card detailing the artist's
 name, phone number ,title of work attached to the
 underside of the work. Please ensure the labelling
 information matches the entry details submitted so we
 can ensure the work is catalogued correctly.
- 3.9 All Youth works on paper entries must either be laminated or framed. Canvas works will be accepted as suitable to hang. All youth photography entries must be framed and ready to hang. The back of the entry must be clearly labelled with the artist's name, age, title of work.
- 3.10 Multi-panel works exceeding three (3) panels will not be accepted.
- 3.11 Any piece of artwork that is not presented to the appropriate standards will not be exhibited.

4.EXHIBITION & AWARDS PRESENTATIONS

- 4.1 All eligible entries will be exhibited to the public at the Morawa Gallery Space at the Old Roads Board from Saturday 23rd August 2025 to Friday 19th September 2025. The Exhibition will be free to enter. Exhibition Opening times will vary depending on staff availability or can be viewed via appointment by contacting the Shire of Morawa Administration Office on 08 9971 1204.
- 4.2 The Exhibition period and opening times are subject to change at the discretion of the Shire of Morawa.
- 4.3 Awards will be announced at the conclusion of the Exhibition period once all votes have been tallied.
- 4.4 Works will be displayed to the best ability of the
 Event Organisers, however if a large number of works
 and limited space this may not meet with your total
 satisfaction. The Shire of Morawa reserves the right not
 to display all works if the quality of the work is not to
 exhibition standard, poses a safety hazard or is deemed
 as inappropriate content.

- 5.1 Artists are advised to insure their work against loss, theft, or damage. All reasonable care will be taken however no responsibility is accepted or loss or damage during delivery or collection of art works.
- 5.2 All artworks must be hand delivered and collected from the Morawa Gallery Space at the Old Roads Board, prior arrangements can be made for entries to be delivered to the Shire Administration Building if you are unable to make the designated times or dates for drop off or delivery at the Old Roads Board.
- 5.3 All entries will only be accepted during the advised dates and all artworks must be collected by 4pm Friday 26 September 2025. The Shire of Morawa will not return any works via post or freight and must be collected by the artist or a person nominated by the artist.
