Road Conditions

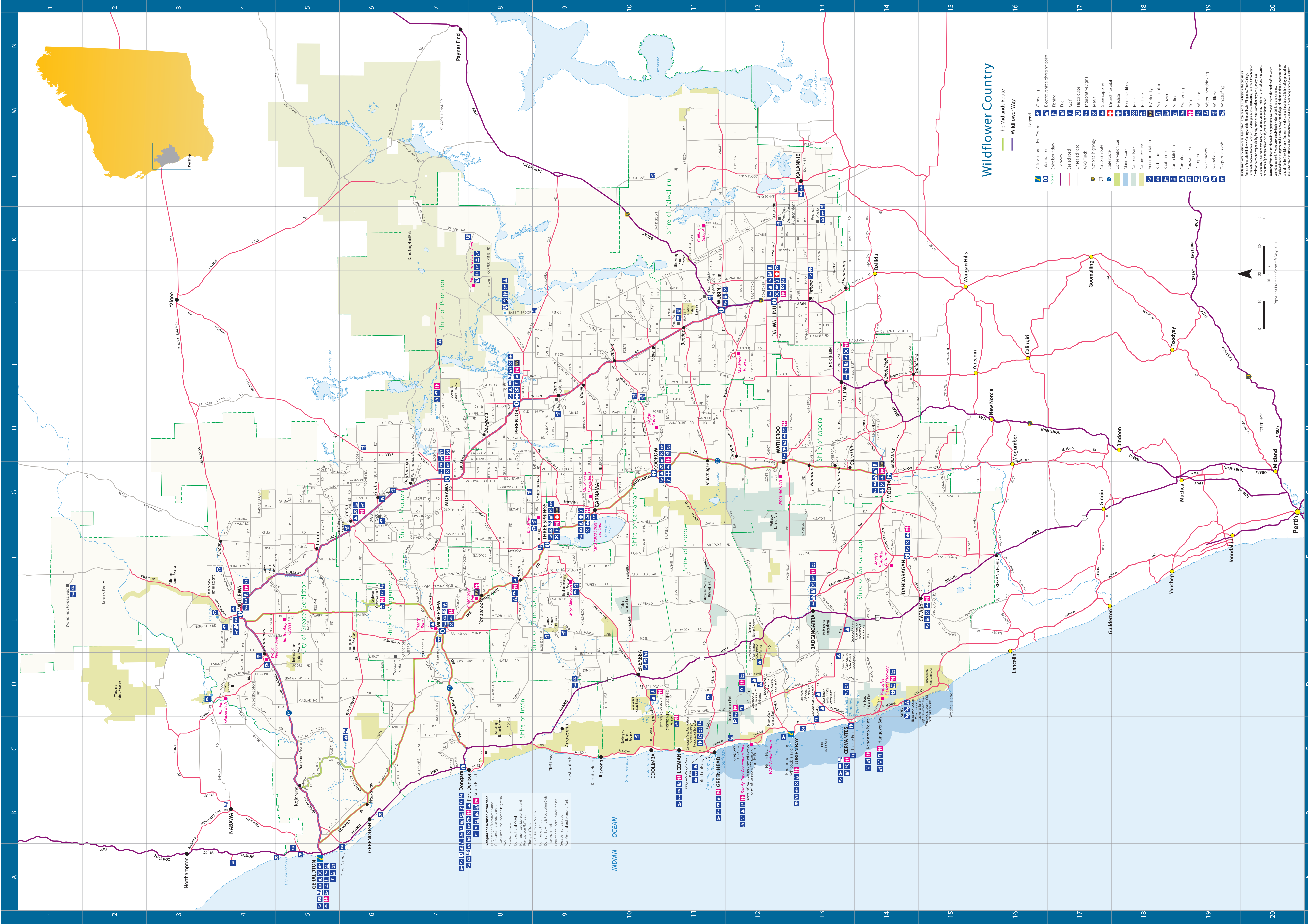
During heavy rain, some of the roads in Wildflower Country can become unsafe and impassable. Check with Main Roads or the local shire before setting out, especially during inclement weather.

Be Prepared

Parts of Wildflower Country are remote and harsh, so if you plan to explore ensure you are prepared. Carry ample supplies of water and fuel and always advise someone you know where you intend on going. If you become stranded always remain with your vehicle. There is at times limited phone reception with Telstra the main phone service working within the region.
