SUMMARY

The purpose of the report is for Council to determine;

- 1. The imposing of a differential rate being a differential Unimproved Valuation (UV) rate for Mining in Morawa at \$0.274580 in the valuation dollar for the 2014-2015 financial year as advertised.
- 2. The imposing of minimum payments for

This represents a 7.5% rate increase for the differential UV mining rate and minimum payments and below the 9.5% rate advertised.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

A local government may impose differential general rates and minimum payments based on the predominant purpose for which the land is held or used as determined by local government. Ministerial approval will need to be obtained to impose minimum rates and a differential rate which is more than twice the lowest differential rate imposed.

The Shire of Morawa has adopted minimum payments and differential rates since 2005. The current approved differential Unimproved Valuation (UV) Rural rate is \$0.0197080 cents in the dollar and for Mining UV in Morawa is \$0.300000 cents in the dollar.

It is proposed that the UV differential Mining Rate and minimum payment for the Shire of Morawa for the 2014/15 financial year should be approved as advertised. This represents a decrease of 12% in the dollar below the previous year for the UV Mining rate and a increase of 7.5% in the minimum payments with an increase in revenue due to an increase in mining tenement valuations.

The UV mining is again more than twice the lowest rate and a minimum rate is being sought hence a council resolution and Ministerial approval is required prior to adopting the annual budget.

OFFICER'S COMMENT

Differential rating and minimum payment schemes adopted in Western Australia range from simple schemes used in pastoral/mining areas where a single differential rate and minimum

payment is used, to those in more populated areas where many differentials may be used. It is suggested that Council continues to adopt a UV Rural Rate, a UV Mining Rate and minimum payments to address the perceived rating anomaly or inequality within the district. Council has advertised the proposed rates for 21 days for public comment, indicating the objects of and reasons for the each rate. No submissions were received. Approval can now be sought from the Minister to impose a differential UV mining rate and minimum payment prior to adoption of the budget.

The proposed rate increase is consistent with the over-all current rate modelling being considered for the adoption of the 2014/2015 Shire of Morawa Annual Budget and allows for a small deviation of the annual rate in the dollar to be approved by Council in adoption of the budget.
