#### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

Council is currently progressing the renovation of the Morawa Swimming Pool with a tender awarded to Safeway Building and Renovation in July 2016.

#### COMMENT

The project is now in its final stages and with the new tiling required as there has been a change in the level of the main pool. This will necessitate an adjustment to the level of the paving surrounding the pool.

The current paving is brick and approximately twenty years old. All paving in the vicinity of pools is required to be flat and non-slip and graded to drain away from the pool. The area to be paved is 630m2.

Two options have been presented. Both proposals include using Shire labour to pull up the existing pavers and stack them on pallets. They are:

To lift the current paving and to relay it to suit the new levels, cost \$64,126.92 ext GST.

To lift the current paving and replace with Australis Stone pavers, cost \$108,859.44 ex GST.

The contractor has been contacted about timelines for completion of the works. The timeline nominated by the contractor is as follows should an order for works be issued today:

Arrive onsite	Last week of November
Completion date	17 December

This would be for either option selected however the contractor has indicated the bricks are quicker to lay. Councillors will also need to be mindful that most building trades have a two week break around Christmas and there may be competing works elsewhere limiting labour and materials available in the lead up to Christmas.
