

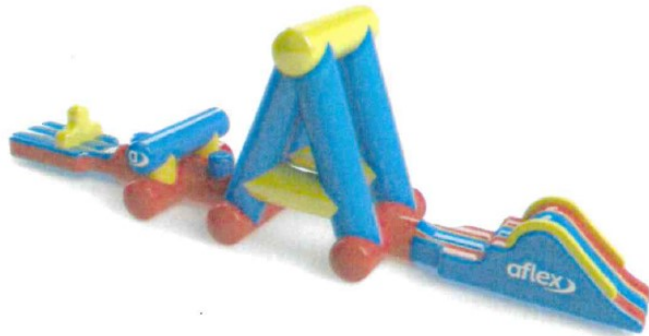
Hello, It is a very busy time for everyone in the Shire at present with harvest well underway. I hope you are all doing well during this busy time.

We have also been busy at the Shire, as we work to conclude a number of projects, as well as preparing to start a long awaited project.

Business Signage has now been installed at three locations on the southern entry and two locations on the northern entry into town. I would like to thank all the businesses that were instrumental in this initiative and encourage everyone to continue supporting all our local businesses.

The pool repair project has been unfortunate, and the timing of it even more so, but we have now completed the repair works and the filling of the pool has commenced (19 November). The process of filling the pool will take up to 10 days to ensure the weight being reintroduced into the pool allows for a gradual increase so not to damage the structure. The project will be concluded, and the pool reopened, once the water quality has been tested and approved. We are still expecting this to be in early December.

We have also purchased a new pool runner that will add a fun new activity to the pool.



We will also begin the works on the Town Hall Kitchen Project in December; this long awaited project will provide a brand new kitchen including flooring, appliances, cabinetry, ceiling and lighting, as well as plumbing and electrical works. I would like to acknowledge the funding support gained from the Federal Government (\$20k) and CBH (\$8k) in supporting this project.

SWIMMING POOLS

Swimming pool inspections will be carried out over the next few weeks. If you have a pool you will need to make sure you have a compliant pool enclosure. Details of required enclosures can be found on this web address <https://www.commerce.wa.gov.au/publications/rules-pools-and-spas>. All pools with over 30cm of water are required to have a compliant enclosure.

FIREBREAKS/ BLOCK CLEARING

Firebreaks and block clearing is now overdue. Inspections have been carried out and where properties are uncleared or firebreaks have not been made fines of up to \$250 will be issued and where necessary your block may be cleared by the Shire at the owner's expense.

Please remember blocks/fire breaks must be kept clear until 16 March 2019.
